


From Fabric 1, cut: (8) 2" x 2" squares

From Fabric 2, cut: (8) 2" x 2" squares

From Fabric 3, cut: (2) 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" squares (1) 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂" square

From Fabric 4, cut: (2) 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" squares



Making the Block:

Finished Size: 9" x 9" Unfinished Size: 9½" x 9½"

- Sew (1) 2" Fabric 2 square to (1) 2" Fabric 1 square. Press the seam toward the Fabric 2 square to make (1) 2" x 3½" two-patch rectangle. Make (8) two-patch rectangles.

- to make (1) 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂" four-patch square. Make (4) four-patch squares.
 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 3⁷/₈" Fabric 3 squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on (1) 3⁷/₈" Fabric 4 square.


Sew (2) two-patch rectangles together as shown. Press the seam open

- Sew ¼" away on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn lines. Press the seam toward toward the Fabric 4 triangles to make (2) 3½" x 3½" HSTs. Make (4) HSTs.

- 5. Lay out (4) four-patch squares, (4) HSTs and (1) 3¹/₂" Fabric 3 square in three rows of three squares each. Sew the squares together in each row. Press the seams in rows 1 and 3 toward the HST squares. Press the seams in row 2 toward the Fabric 3 square.
- 6. Join the rows. Press the seams open to make (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " block.



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
