


*From Fabric 1, cut:* (2) 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares (4) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares


*From Fabric 2, cut:* (2) 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares (1) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square



Making the Block:

Finished Size: 9" x 9" Unfinished Size: 9½" x 9½"

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric 1 squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on (1) 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric 2 square.
- Sew ¼" away on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam toward the Fabric 2 triangle to make (1) 3½" x 3½" HST. Make (4) HSTs.



- 3. Lay out (4) HSTs, (4) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric 1 squares and (1) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric 2 square in three rows of three squares each, noting the placement and orientation of each HST. Sew the squares together in each row. Press the seams in rows 1 and 3 toward the Fabric 1 squares. Press the seams in row 2 toward the Fabric 1 squares.
- 4. Join the rows. Press the seams open to make (1)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " block.
