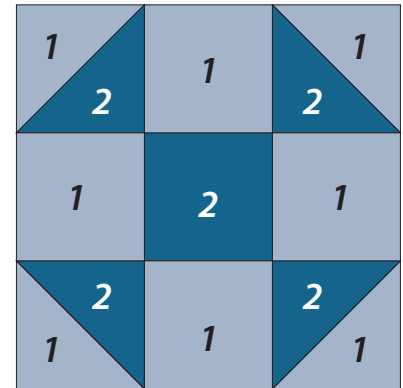

From Fabric 1, cut:
 (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
 (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric 2, cut:
 (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
 (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square



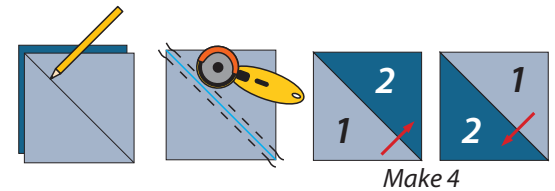
Making the Block:

Finished Size: 9" x 9"

Unfinished Size: $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ "

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 1 squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 2 square.

2. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam toward the Fabric 2 triangle to make (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " HST. Make (4) HSTs.



3. Lay out (4) HSTs, (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 1 squares and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 2 square in three rows of three squares each, noting the placement and orientation of each HST. Sew the squares together in each row. Press the seams in rows 1 and 3 toward the Fabric 1 squares. Press the seams in row 2 toward the Fabric 1 squares.
4. Join the rows. Press the seams open to make (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " block.
