Making the Block:

Finished Size: 9" x 9"


Unfinished Size: 9½" x 9½"

From Fabric 1, cut:
(2) 3½" x 3½" squares

From Fabric 2, cut:
(4) 3½" x 3½" squares

From Fabric 3, cut:
(6) 2" x 2" squares

From Fabric 4, cut:
(6) 2" x 2" squares



- Sew (1) 2" Fabric 3 square to (1) 2" Fabric 4 square. Press the seam toward the Fabric 3 square to make (1) 2" x 3½" two-patch rectangle. Make (6) two-patch rectangles.
- Sew (2) two-patch rectangles together as shown. Press the seam open to make (1) 3½" x 3½" four-patch square. Make (3) four-patch squares.
- Lay out (3) four-patch squares, (4) 3½" Fabric 2 squares and (2) 3½" Fabric 1 squares in three rows of three squares each. Sew the squares together in each row. Press the seams toward the Fabric 2 squares.
- Join the rows. Press the seams open to make (1) 9½" x 9½" block.
